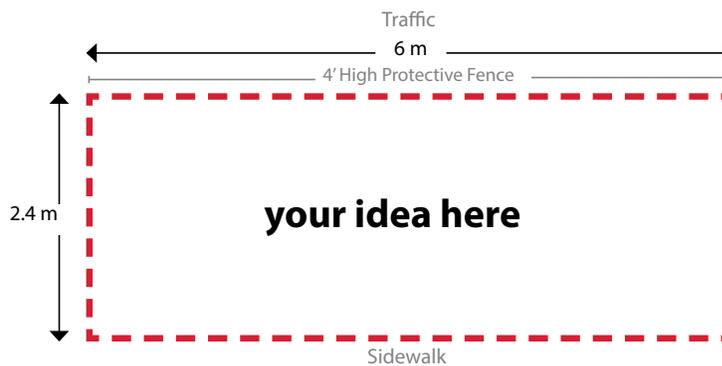

## PARK(ING) STALL CONSIDERATIONS



- Installations must be sturdy and safe, weather resistant, and not interfere with traffic.
- Installations are required to incorporate a 4' high protective fence (provided by event organizers) to separate the installation from vehicular traffic.
- Teams are responsible for the design, materials, fabrication, transportation, installation and removal of their installations for the event, including associated costs.
- Installations will require one representative at minimum, on-site during the entire event.
- Signage is limited to two posters, no larger than 11 by 17 inches in size, that serve the sole purpose of acknowledging the creators, funders or organizers of the PARK(ing) Day Installation.
- Setup from 10 am to 12 pm, and take-down from 6 pm to 8 pm.
